

Privacy Policy

The Bridge places a high priority on protecting your privacy. This privacy policy was created in order to demonstrate our agency's firm commitment to the privacy of our donors and website users. This policy explains what types of information is collected by the The Bridge's website, www.bridגעac.org, and how this information is used.

What Personally Identifiable Information is Collected

Individuals who sign up to receive The Bridge e-communications voluntarily provide us with contact information (such as name and e-mail address). We may use this information for specific, limited purposes. You may always "opt out," either now or at any time in the future, if you do not wish to receive our messages.

IP addresses

The Bridge uses your IP address to help diagnose problems with our server, to administer www.bridגעac.org and for statistical metrics used to track website visitor traffic.

Cookies

www.bridגעac.org uses "cookie" messages to automatically help provide better services. They remind us who you are and your preferences for our website based on what you've done and told us before. The "cookie" is placed in your computer and is read when you come back to our website. Cookies let us take you to the information and features you're particularly interested in. They also let us track your usage of www.bridגעac.org, so we know which parts of our sites are most popular. You can reject cookies or cancel them by instructing your Web browser accordingly.

How Your Information May Be Used

We use your personal information to provide you with personalized service; to send e-mail alerts to you; to answer your requests; to process your donations; etc. You may choose to opt out at any time, which will cease all communications from us. We may also use your information to track visitors of our website. This lets us see which of our features are the most popular so we can better serve our users' needs. It also lets us provide aggregate data about our traffic (not identifying you personally, but showing how many visitors used which features, for example) to outside parties.

Email Privacy

The Bridge does not provide, sell, or rent email addresses to anyone outside the organization.
